Lost Cities of Almolonga “Valley Ride” (Beginner to Intermediate Ride)

This tour is named for the Almolonga Valley - just west of Antigua - which was home of the 2nd Capital of Guatemala - Ciudad Vieja. The old city met a fateful doom in 1541 as a result of a terrible mudslide released from the crater of Agua Volcano. The city disappeared in the valley between Agua, Fuego & Acatenango volcanoes; however, the exact site of the old city is still the source of much debate...

-] Escape Antigua for the day and tour the countryside by mountain bike
-] See ruins one earthquake away from extinction
-] Visit Lorenzo's experimental macadamia farm at Valhalla - a sustainable agriculture project
-] Explore the villages of Santiago Zamora and San Antonio Aguas Calientes, famous for their textiles and weavings
