



Overview:

Iximché is an archaeological site in the western highlands of Guatemala. The architecture of the site included a number of pyramid-temples, palaces and two Mesoamerican ballcourts. The ruins of Iximche were declared a Guatemalan National Monument in the 1960s. And its only 1 ½ hour half drive from Antigua.

Itinerary:

Our group leaves from Maximo Nivel at 1:00 pm. From there we will hop in a private shuttle to Iximché ruins. After 1 ½ hour driving up through the highlands, we reach Iximché where a guided tour through the ruins will let us discover its incredible history.
