



Rio Coyolate White Water Rafting

In coordination with RIOS Guatemala, we are offering the only white water rafting experience available in the Antigua area. This day trip offers your group an exciting day of class II and III+ rapids on the Coyolate River. This full day tour includes all the gear you need plus breakfast, snack lunch, and dinner.

Our group meets at Old Town Outfitters Shop in Antigua at 06:00 AM - where drinking water, bathroom facilities and retail outdoor equipment are available for our clients. Our drive to the staging area is approximately 1.5 hours in private transport from Antigua. We will arrive and have breakfast before starting the day.

We will provide you with all the safety information before entering the river. The trip is a 22km trip that last about 5½ hours depending on the levels of the river. We will have drinks and snacks on the river and then end back at basecamp with a great dinner (around 4:00 PM) to wrap up the river experience. We then return to Antigua, arriving at approximately 6:30 PM.
